Each center program was led by a CalArts alumni Lead instructor and assisted by either a team of hired Student Instructors or Pedagogy Student Instructors enrolled in a pedagogy practicum course. The course centered on Intro to Animation and students were able to use animation platforms using iPads to create animation shorts.
