Topic 1: Overview and purpose of PAC	<p>Nafisa Nahrin, staff member, explained the purpose of PAC and outlined the duties of all committee members. She highlighted the importance of parent and student involvement, the need for feedback from both parties, and how this contributes to school improvement. After her presentation, the floor was opened for questions, but no questions were asked.</p>
Topic 2: LCAP overview 24-27	<p>Guest presenter, Ms. Stephanie Grey, Assistant Principal of Operations, explained the purpose of LCAP. The presenter reported on the current LCAP goals and metrics. She reviewed several goals and reported on current metrics for the charter. She highlighted big gains for the subpopulation, including EL and SPED.</p> <p>The floor was open for questions; none were posed, but the parent commented that she loves OFL and that the school has helped all kids grow.</p>
Topic 3: School Safety Policy	<p>Guest presenter Stephanie Grey presented on a comprehensive school safety plan and provided updates on newly added sections, which include “Routine and Emergency Disaster Procedure” and “Procedure for Safe Ingress and Egress.” Other components included: Routine & Emergency Disaster Procedures, Discipline Policy, Child Abuse Reporting Procedures, and Other Topics Covered in School Safety Plan.</p> <p>The floor was open for questions; none were asked.</p>

Meeting Concluded:

Nafisa asked the committee to share their feedback on the School's BTSN event. She wondered how the school could improve parent engagement. Nafisa paused and opened up the floor for members to provide input on the LCAP or School Safety Policy.

- 1) Gen Ed parent suggests centralizing information so it is more accessible to parents, especially regarding the clubs and teams offered to students.
- 2) SPED parent also says it would be better if information regarding trips were communicated to parents prior to the interview process for students. More texts and emails would be preferred.
- 3) One Gen Ed parent asked for more communication via email and text, and for more support for non-English speakers.
- 4) One Gen Ed parent mentioned that he was unaware of BTSN and wished it had been communicated to him because the Pastries with Parents event was great. Similar to other parents, he also wants more communication.
